**GIVEN THAT**

*Municipality of Tuzi* is partner of the project: CIVIC ENERGY FUTURE: SUSTAINABLE LOCAL ENERGY COMMUNITIES (hereinafter referred to as LEC Project)

LEC Project, aims to improve the energy efficiency and renewable energy usage through the development of “local community of active energy consumers” (LEC) which cooperates with municipalities (public-private partnerships), by encouraging the sustainable Municipalities models through local actions in accordance with the change in the citizens behavior.

LEC Project Partners has shared a common LEC MODEL to define the potential members of the LOCAL ENERGY COMMUNITY and their role and functions



LEC Project provides funds for the implementation of Pilot Action to be considered as a demonstration tool concerning the application of the "common action plan" according to the LEC Model, or through an active involvement of the citizens/users.

The Pilot action is implemented by replacing wooden worn windows with pvc/aluminum joinery in High mixed school "25 May" and also provided the installation of PVC hexagonal hardware with steel reinforcements and thermopan glass.

- 2) PRIVATE USER (CITIZENS, STUDENTS),

- *to promote the provision of innovative technological services*
- *to encourage the creation of new models of local energy communities developing strategies and tools for local energy systems in collaboration with local authorities*
- *to encourage an energy transition towards a more decentralized, more efficient, more flexible, and mostly based on energy produced from renewable sources.*
